2. Rights of the data subject

2.1 Right to information in accordance with Art. 15 GDPR

You have the right to receive information free of charge at any time as to whether we are processing your personal data.

2.2 Right to rectification pursuant to Art. 16 GDPR, right to erasure pursuant to Art. 17 GDPR, right to restriction of processing pursuant to Art. 18 GDPR, right to data portability pursuant to Art. 20 GDPR and the right to object pursuant to Art. 21 GDPR

You also have the option of exercising your rights to rectification, erasure or restriction of processing. You can also object to the processing of your data at any time.

2.3 Revocation in the event of consent pursuant to Art. 7 para. 3 GDPR

3. Processing of your data when using this website

3.1 Logging / Logging

When you visit our website, the browser used on your device automatically transmits information to the server of our website. This information is temporarily stored in a so-called log file.

The following information is stored without any action on your part

- IP address of the requesting computer,
- Website from which the access is made (so-called referrer URL)
- Browser type and version and other information transmitted by the browser (e.g. the operating system of your computer) and the language
- Date and time of the request
- Time zone difference to Greenwich Mean Time (GMT)
- Access status / HTTP status code
- the amount of data transferred in each case

The data processing is carried out in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f GDPR in conjunction with § 25 para. 2 no. 2 TTDSG to ensure the trouble-free operation of our website and to evaluate system security and stability. The data collected will not be used to draw conclusions about your person.

The stored data is saved in the log files for a maximum of 7 days and then deleted. Data whose further storage is required for evidence purposes is excluded from deletion until the respective incident has been finally clarified.

Only the logging data (see point 3.1) is collected. The processing of your order and the processing of the data required for this is carried out exclusively via the ERP system used by us, which is separate from the ShareUC offer.

4. External service providers

For the operation of this website, we use the services of the service provider Xiamen Guanghua Digital Textile Technology Co, Ltd No.S304, Weiye Building, Incubator Park, Huli District Fujian, Fujian 361006, China, which specializes in the provision of visualization software.

We cannot rule out the possibility that personal data may be transferred outside the legal area of the European Union, i.e. to servers located in China. In this regard, we expressly point out that no equivalent level of data protection can be guaranteed for China. We have concluded EU standard contractual clauses (Module 2) with the service provider in order to ensure that the processing of personal data is as compliant with data protection regulations as possible and to guarantee that the data is only processed on our instructions.
